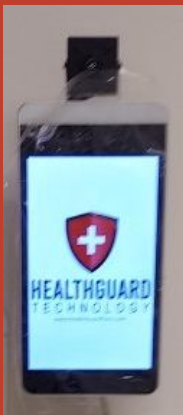

A Safe Space



When students return to campus, they must "temperature check" every day. Why? To protect the campus, other students and staff from the possibility of COVID-19.

These kiosks will measure temperature in just seconds. Anyone with a temperature of 100.0 or higher will not be allowed on the campus.

Parents, please remember that students must wear their masks at all times on campus. We want EVERYONE to be safe at The Lawson Academy.

Limited Bus Service for Returning Students

Since we are social distancing due to the COVID-19 pandemic, seating is restricted on our school buses. If your student needs to ride our bus, they must be at the bus stop early on Day 1. When the maximum number of students is reached, we won't let any other rider on the bus.



If you can drive your student to/from the campus, please do so. That will allow students who don't have cars to use our free transportation.

Campus Safety Protocols: 2.

- All staff and students must be temperature checked at the designated area on campus
- Parents must complete a daily online health check questionnaire and are strongly advised not to send students to school under any circumstance should the child feel ill or exhibit cold-like symptoms.
- Staff members are to complete a health questionnaire and are advised not to report to campus if not feeling well or experiencing cold-like symptoms.
- Social distancing of 6 feet or more should be maintained at all times by all campus personnel and students.
- Handwashing frequently particularly after touching surfaces
- Facial masks are **MANDATORY**.
- All classes will follow a restroom schedule which allows students three restroom breaks throughout the school day. There will be strict cleaning protocol which allows the students to enter an environment that has been thoroughly cleaned and sanitized following each student use.
- Only two students will be allowed to enter the restroom at any time. A hallway restroom monitor will be assigned to each restroom to ensure that all safety procedures are closely followed
- There should be absolutely no sharing of pencils, pens, paper, or any other items. Students are responsible for bringing needed supplies to school.
- Students are required to bring to school at least two bottles of water (no frozen bottles of water or sodas). All campus water fountains will not be available for student use.
- All staff and students should follow the entry and exit signs posted on the doors and in the hallways. (Exiting and Entering traffic to the right side of the hallway).

Monitoring for COVID-19

The Lawson Academy will monitor students, staff, vendors and visitors prior to entrance for COVID-19 symptoms: Has they recently begun experiencing any of the following in a way that is not normal for them?

- Feeling feverish or a temperature greater

than or equal to 100.0 degrees Fahrenheit

- Loss of taste or smell
- Cough, difficulty breathing or shortness of breath
- Fatigue, headache, chills
- Sore throat, congestion or runny nose

In the event a student shows COVID-19 symptoms, the Academy will immediately separate the student while at school until the student can be picked up by a parent or guardian.

The Academy will clean all areas used by the individual who shows COVID-19 symptoms while at school (student, teacher, or staff). Students who report feeling feverish should be given an immediate temperature check to determine if they are symptomatic for COVID-19.



Is Your Laptop Working?



Every student has been 'checked out' a laptop or a desktop with camera and headphones. If your student is properly caring for the equipment, great!

For students who have "white screens" or other damage, the equipment can be replaced but **parents are responsible for repair or replacement costs**. Please make sure students take care of their computers. They are needed to learn!
